Following the service most people walked down to the Memorial to relay the wreaths with a short service.

We are committed as an Association to continue this Service/Parade into the future as is Sir Adrian and Tom. We need to somehow raise its profile and get other Associations involved. We believe it is a very important event and to my knowledge it is the only Fleet Air Arm memorial service.
